Grey Bruce Health Unit

The Grey Bruce Health Unit needed a classleading building to serve Grey-Bruce counties while keeping environmental concerns at the forefront. The Health Unit Building was designed to accommodate the growing needs of the surrounding communities, through environmentally sustainable state-of-the-art facilities.

The resulting new structure lives up to its promise beautifully, while meeting LEED environmental certification. Nothing less was expected of the company tasked with furnishing the building's offices. Tayco was chosen to provide a comfortable, forwardlooking office space, using materials that help the structure exceed the requirements of LEED standards.

Workstations incorporate innovations such as low-emitting materials, and are arranged to promote employee interaction. Each workstation has access to natural light by keeping them on the perimeter of the office space, with the centre reserved for the filing system. This reduced the requirement for artificial light, reducing energy costs and providing a more hospitable atmosphere, and satisfied LEED credit 8.1 and 8.2. All furniture specified for this facility is Greenguard Certified for indoor air quality and complies with LEED credit 4.5.
