Installation Checklist

Perform a site inspection prior to the installation date to check existing site conditions and identify constraints and limitations that could possibly cause delays or problems during the actual installation.

SITE ACCESSIBILITY

- 1. Verify existing loading facilities and proximity of loading dock to staging area.
- 2. Verify if receiving area is accessible by trailer.
- 3. Verify access to service elevators.
- 4. Reserve service elevators in advance, if necessary.

SITE PREPARATION

- 1. Clear all obstacles that could interfere with the installation process.
- 2. When doing a reconfiguration, ensure that all furniture to be re-used are clear of computers, accessories, books, papers and all personal effects.
- 3. Ensure that all live wires and data/communications wires are disconnected prior to installation.

FURNITURE PLANS

1. Labeled furniture plans for installation purposes are located in the hardware box. Ensure that drawings are complete and handy before beginning installation.

STAGING

- 1. If damages are noticed upon opening the trailer, these must be noted by the receiver on the Bill of Lading. Also note any imperfections or missing components discovered while unpacking the furniture. This information is necessary when requesting for product replacement and shipping claims.
- 2. Unpack products in the general order of installation (refer to Installation Sequence).

WASTE MANAGEMENT

1. Establish a trash removal area separate from the product staging area.

Care & Maintenance

Laminates

Dust laminated surfaces for regular maintenance. Clean any dirt or stain with a damp cloth. Do not use an excessive amount of water, abrasive cleaners, acids or alkalis and do not scratch or scrape surfaces. For persistent stains and marks use a commercial cleaner, such as Cabinet Magic® or Countertop Magic®, both manufactured by Magic American Corporation.

Painted Metals

Tayco's painted metal products are powder-paint-coated. To clean these products, use a damp cloth, using only a small amount of lukewarm water if necessary. Dry with a clean a dry cloth. To avoid scratching and damaging the painted surface, do not use hard bristled brushes or abrasive.

Load Bottom Drawer First

- Operate one drawer at a time.
- Units may tip if loaded incorrectly.
- Units should be attached to a wall or other furniture to reduce tipping hazards.
- Always load the heaviest files in the bottom drawer.

Heavy Load


- Some products must be anchored to the wall to ensure stability & safety.
- It is the owner and installer's responsibility to ensure that the wall type and construction are of sufficient strength to carry loads of any wall-mounted products and their contents.
- Failure of the wall and anchors to support all imposed loads may result in property damage and/or personal injury.
- Tayco can provide the size and empty weight of its products only. A wall blocking is considered a building construction process, Tayco cannot provide recommendations in this respect and cannot be responsible for damage or injury that may occur as a result of improper installation and/or blocking.

Instability Hazard


Mobile items on casters such as flip tops, personal and movable tables of any type, and storage items of any type may present an instability hazard if not secured correctly while in use or storage. Flip-top tables or training tables of any type are inherently more unstable when folded. Tayco provides the following guidelines & warnings when using mobile products:

- Lock casters immediately after moving. Do not leave the casters unlocked when in use or storage.
- Motion may increase the instability of any item with casters. If the wheels hit an obstruction the table's forward momentum often causes overturn, especially if the item is not equipped with wheel extensions. Exercise strong caution while moving these items.
- Use caution when abrupt level changes in the floor are present (such as a doorway or room threshold) as caster failure or tipping may result.
- Do not stand, sit or lean on mobile items for support. They are not intended for this use and personal injury or property damage may result.
- Mobile units that feature height-adjustable elements must be lowered to the minimum compressed height when moving to prevent instability. It is also recommended the user remove all computer equipment or other accessories to prevent possible weight imbalance or damage to equipment.
- Failure to follow the guidelines above may result in property damage or personal injury.


Blade Extrusion Hole Location




Scene Post Location



Acrylic Screen with Post and Flat Bracket

- 1. Install the screen posts (1) using #8 X 1" Flat Head Screws, please see Shield Screens Application Guide to determine the post location.
- 2. Slide in the bottom aluminum bar extrusion (2) within the posts.


Note: For Raised Screens, insert the 4" high Post Spacer Cap Vinyl Retainers first then the bottom aluminum bar extrusion.

- 3. Insert screen vertical vinyl retainer (3) into the groove of post until it bottoms out.
- **4.** Insert the acrylic (4) into the vertical vinyl retainers within the posts.
- **5.** Place the top aluminum bar extrusion (5) on top of acrylic.
- **6.** Install post cap vinyl retainers (6) to the posts.
- 7. Snap on the screen post top caps(7).




- 6 POST CAP VERTICAL VINYL RETAINER




- (3) POST CAP VERTICAL VINYL RETAINER



- 3. Mark the location of the D-shaped glass clamp 4.
 Note: Ensure the bottom cutout of the acrylic and the D-shaped glass clamp 4 are aligned before mounting the clamp to surface.
- **4.** Attach the D-shaped glass clamp 4using #10 X 11/16"5
- **5.** Insert the acrylic with square corners (a) into the vertical vinyl retainers until it bottoms out.


Note: Ensure the bottom cutout of the acrylic is snug fit on the D-shaped glass clamp 4.

- **6.** Tighten the screws of the D-shaped glass clamp gently using an allen key until the glass/acrylic is secured.
- 7. Install post cap vinyl retainers 7 to the post.
- **8.** Snap on the screen post top caps (8).








- **1.** Get the acrylic screen (1).

- **3.** Attach the 1/4-20 X 3/8 Flange Button-Head Screws 4 through the holes of the back plate 3.
- **4.** Tighten gently each screw until the acrylic is secured.
- **5.** Position the assembled parts to the middle of surface (5).
- **6.** Attach the "L" plate 2 underneath the surface using #10 X 11/16" Oval Head Screw 6.











- 4. Tighten gently each screw until the acrylic 1 is secured.
- 5. Position the assembled parts to the middle of surface (5).
- **6.** Attach the "L" plate (2) underneath the surface using #10 X 11/16" Oval Head Screw(6).






- ACRYLIC SCREEN




- **1.** Check frameless blade 1 extrusion if there is a Xmas tree clip 2 on both ends.
- **2.** Position the frameless blade extrusion 1 to the middle of top trim.
- **3.** Securely fasten frameless blade extrusion on top trim using #8 X 2" Flat Head Self Drilling Screws(3).

NOTE: Make sure there is something solid for the screws to bite into to secure the frameless blade extrusion, please see Shield Screens Application Guide, Blade Extrusion Hole Location.

- **4.** Install glass/acrylic with plastic gasket 4 into the frameless blade extrusion 1.
- **5.** Align and secure the glass/acrylic by inserting 1/4-20 X 1/4" Socket Set Screw (5) through each of the holes on the side of the frameless blade extrusion 1 using allen key driver.
- **6.** Tighten gently each side until the glass/acrylic is centered and secured.

Note: Do not overtighten.



FREESTANDING SHIELD W/ STATIONARY WING BASE

- **1.** Get the laminate with 4 bored holes (1).
- **2.** Sandwich the laminate between the two shield singular bases (2).

NOTE: Stick the Black Sponge Neoprene with adhesive backed at the lower face bottom of the Shield Singular Base before installing it on the laminate.

3. Connect the shield singular bases² to laminate 1 by inserting the 1/4-20 X 30mm Barrel Nut 3 into the holes and screwing the 1/4-20 X 30mm JCB-Bolt 4 into it.





- 1. Attach the gallery wall square tube(2)to laminate(1) using #6 X 1 3/4" Flat Head Screws 3.
- 2. Assemble the "D" feet by attaching the screen base "U" channel 4 to foot base 5 using 1/4-20 X 3/4" long Flat Head Screws 6.
- **3.** Attach the "D" feet to gallery wall square tube 2 using JCB Bolt with Hex Key Head (7) and the 50 MM long JCB-BW Lag Bolt (8) to the laminate 1.



- Assemble the "D" feet (1) to laminate ? Please refer to page 19. Follow Steps 1 to 3 on how to install them.
- 2. Check frameless blade (3) extrusion if there is a Xmas tree clip 4 on both ends.
- 3. Position the frameless blade extrusion(3) to the middle of top trim.
- **4.** Securely fasten frameless blade extrusion (3) to laminate(2) using #8 X 2" Flat Head Self, Drilling Screws (5).
- **5.** Install glass/acrylic with plastic gasket 6 into the frameless blade extrusion 3.
- **6.** Align and secure the glass/ acrylic by inserting 1/4-20 X 1/4" Socket Set Screw (7) through each of the holes on the side of the frameless blade extrusion (3) using allen key driver.
- 7. Tighten gently each side until the glass/acrylic is centered and secured.

Note: Do not overtighten. Check the frameless blade extrusion if it is straight. Overtightening set screws will bend the Frameless Blade Extrusion outward and end caps will not fit.





 - **3.** Sandwich the laminate between two skate feet 3.
 - 4. Connect the skate feet to laminate by inserting the 1/4-20 X 30MM Barrel Nut 4 into the holes and screwing the 1/4-20 X 30MM JCB-Bolt 5 into it.



- 2. Check frameless blade extrusion (3) if there is a Xmas tree clip (4) on both ends.
- **3.** Position the frameless blade extrusion 3 to the middle of top trim.
- **4.** Securely fasten frameless blade extrusion 3 to laminate 2 ,using #8 X 2" Flat Head Self Drilling Screws 5.
- **5.** Install glass/acrylic with plastic gasket ⓐ into the frameless blade extrusion ③.
- 6. Align and secure the glass/ acrylic by inserting 1/4-20 X 1/4" Socket Set Screw⁷ through each of the holes on the side of the frameless blade extrusion³ using allen key driver.
- **7.** Tighten gently each side until the glass/acrylic is centered and secured.

Note: Do not overtighten. Check the frameless blade extrusion if it is straight. Overtightening set screws will bend the frameless blade extrusion outward and end caps will not fit.
